

### Troubling Miami Valley facts.....

1. Montgomery County is #1 nationally for drug overdose deaths as of September 2016.
2. Twelve thousand individuals in Montgomery County are currently addicted.
3. Three hundred children in Montgomery County need foster care due to drugs.
5. There has been an 87% rise in drug episodes involving EMT's in Kettering alone.
6. Skittles parties are on the rise. (Teens indiscriminately swipe parents' medications and bring them to parties where they ingest miscellaneous pills without knowing what they are. An addictive personality can become instantly hooked.)
7. Prime age men (ages 25-54) in the Ohio labor force has declined significantly due to drugs. The rate for this population has tumbled from 98% in 1954 to 88% currently.
